We will be collecting pre-packed "snacks" for this mission project until Sunday, Sept. 14th. There is a collection box in the Foyer. Please note there can be **NO Homemade snacks!**

On Wednesday, Sept. 17th @ 5:45 PM, we will have our regular scheduled Family Meal. Following the meal, the children will hear a story, from a special guest, about the mission emphasis. After the story time, the children will return to the Fellowship Hall to begin packing the "treat" bags.

On Saturday, Sept. 20th @ 10:00 AM, we will gather at the Fellowship Hall and then begin delivery of the bags. These bags will be distributed to our First Responders in Crisp County (Police Dept., Sherriff Dept., EMT's, and Fire Dept.).
